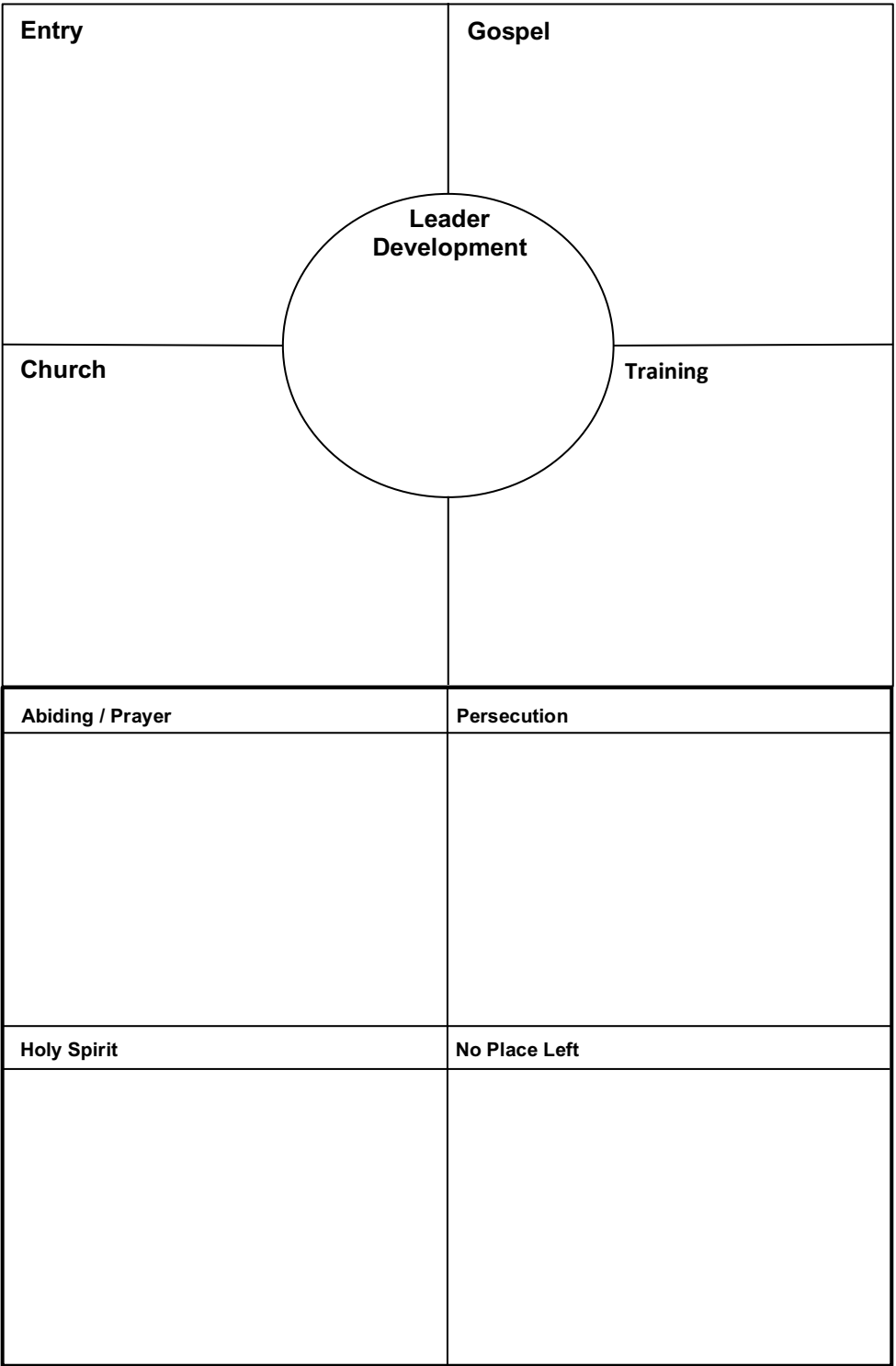


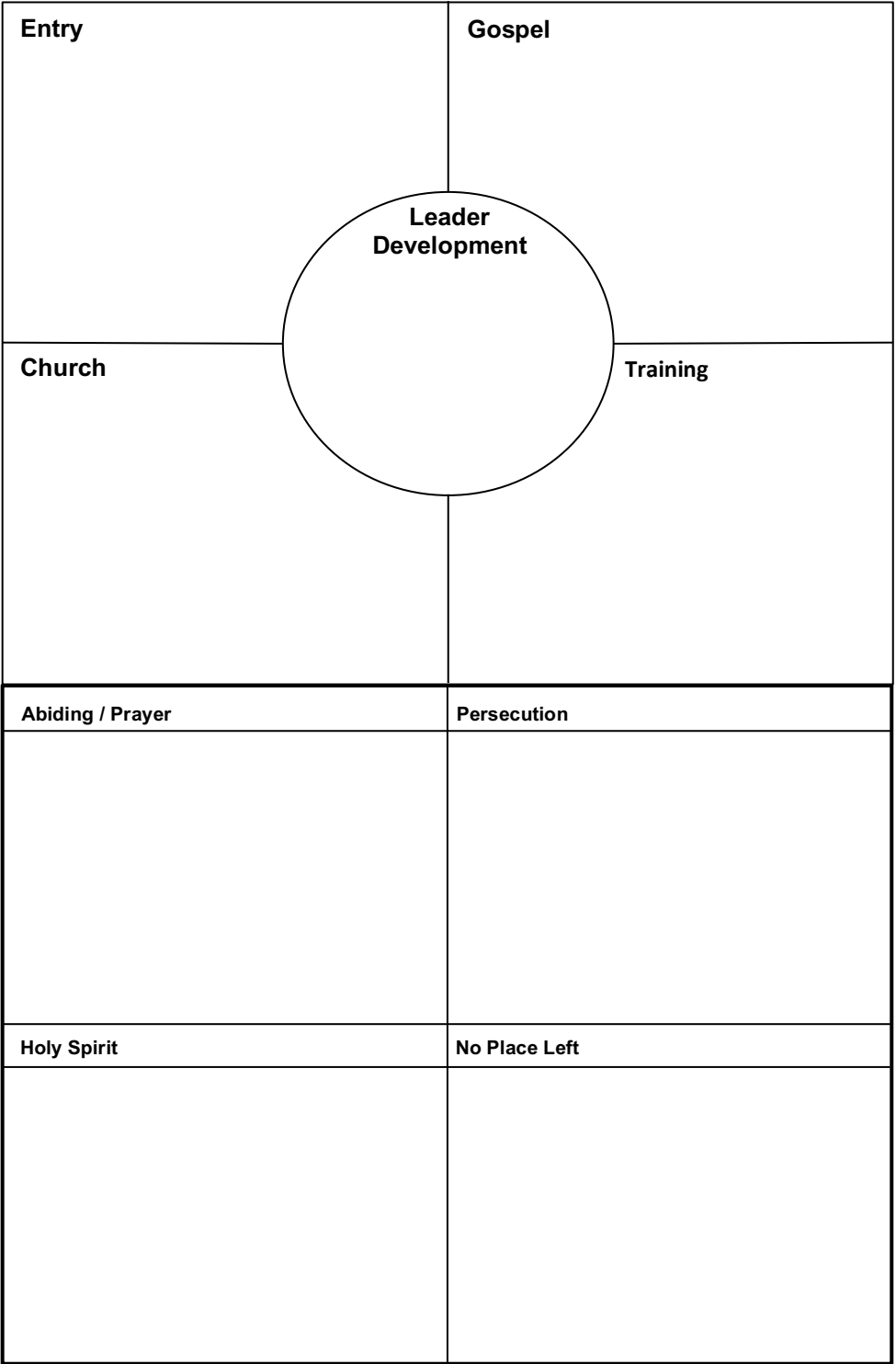
Abiding / Prayer	Persecution
